Your e-mail hereunder together with our telephone conversation in this regard bears reference.

Kindly bear in mind that the Registrar cannot allow or approve names that construe itself as the provision of the Act of Parliament. In view of that, you cannot employ Sec 27 of the Constitution of the Land to serve as the name of an entity or any organization.

If you want to incorporate Section 27 of the Constitution of the South African Act, you need to obtain a written consent from the Parliament of South Africa.

I have taken in cognisance the fact that you want to transform the organization to include research, advocacy and legal action to which I do not have any problem with. Any entity or organization can register to promote activities under Sec 27 of the Constitution, but cannot name itself after that Section.

It is therefore my advise that you may coach or qualify the word Section 27 with the Geographical area such as : Section 27 Tshwane Aids Law Projects ect

In view of the above, I am unable to review my decision.
