THE MICHAEL KOMAPE SANITATION PROGRESS MONITOR

The Michael Komape Sanitation Progress Monitor is an accountability tool launched by SECTION27 in partnership with the Centre for Child Law to track progress made by the Limpopo Department of Education (LDoE) to eliminate unsafe and undignified sanitation at public schools throughout the Limpopo province and install safe and decent sanitation facilities.

The Michael Komape Sanitation Progress Monitor is named after the five-year-old learner, Michael Komape, who drowned in a pit toilet at his school in Limpopo in 2014.

Following SECTION27's interventions, the High Court in Limpopo handed down judgment in the Michael Komape case in September 2021, compelling the LDoE to provide a list of schools with pit toilets and other inadequate sanitation, plans to eradicate these and, upgrade school sanitation in the province and to report every six months on progress. The LDoE has until 31 March 2023 to replace pit toilets from all "Priority One Schools" that rely only on pit toilets in the province.

The Michael Komape Sanitation Progress Monitor allows you to track progress and hold the LDoE accountable for meeting their deadlines to deliver safe sanitation facilities in Limpopo schools.

It also tracks the following:

- ✓ Number of basic pit toilets
- ✓ Number of toilets required to meet norms and standards
- ✓ Number of existing appropriate toilets
- ✓ Backlog number of toilets required and more

The Department of Education has a Constitutional obligation to protect the rights of learners at schools, and SECTION27 continues to seek justice and ask, how many more learners need to die before the call to accountability is heeded?
